The meeting starts following the discussion as per the proposed agenda.

1. Reunion 2024: organisational updates

The reunion is confirmed on September 21st in Venice. It is important to figure out as soon as possible the approximate number of participants. To be noted that on September 19th and 20th the Celebration of 20th years of Origini course will be held in Trieste and the participants could join the Alumni Reunion in Venice. By the end of May we should know the number of Origini students who will participate in the reunion in Trieste (expected between 100 and 200).

Among the different options evaluated for the dinner on Sept 21st, the most favourable for guests capacity and menu/price ratio is Ristorante Bacaro where an *apericena* or a fixed menu dinner can be organised for up to 150 persons at a price of 50-60 €. 50% of prepayment is required to book the restaurant. Before booking, someone within the council members should go on site to have a look at the location. Updates to be shared in the next council meeting.

About the accommodation, after discussion of all possibilities, the Council decided not to pre-book hotels for potential comers but to indicate how to reach Venice by public transportation considering that people could prefer to select hotels outside of Venice city.

About the activities to be held on Sunday Sept 22nd, in addition to the visit to the Human Safety Net org exposition (ticket included for the participants to the reunion), at least 2 more activities should be selected among the list of options proposed by Nicoletta. The selection should take into consideration the need for many attendants to leave Venice early in the afternoon to go back home and to diversify the entertainment activities. Nicoletta and Valentina will report during the next council meeting.

About the management of the registration, we will ask support to the MIB marketing office for the graphical content and the registration for the event. A confirmation email should be sent to the participants. Matteo and Clara will work on the social media serialised communication to stimulate the engagement of recipients.

The draft agenda, including the potential key note and speakers should be defined and submitted to MIB School for agreement.

2. Local Events: updates
