#### 1. Review Post-reunion 2025

- To be organized an event in Trieste; the issues here is to find volunteers in the Trieste alumni community to help in the organization of a MIB Talk

A LinkedIn call-to-action will be launched to encourage alumni to actively participate in organizing local activities. Additionally, Valentina Maraldi will prepare a post-reunion survey to gather further feedback, including a question about members' willingness to help organize events. The council also discussed strengthening ties between the MIB Alumni network and other associations where alumni are active, highlighting opportunities for collaboration. Upcoming sports and leisure initiatives highlighted during the Alumni Reunion, namely the MBA Football Cup and the "MIB on the Snow" event, should be promoted more widely through the social channels.
