## ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED BY ASSICURAZIONI GENERALI S.p.A. DEDICATED TO THE MEMORY OF DIEGO SASTRE GARCÍA

MIB Trieste School of Management is honored to announce a competition for one Scholarship, offered by **Assicurazioni Generali S.p.A.** dedicated to the memory of **Diego Sastre García**, participant of the 1<sup>st</sup> edition of Generali-MIB Master in Insurance Management, who has prematurely passed away.

The Scholarship covers 100% of the tuition fees for the XXVIII edition of the Master in Insurance and Risk Management (full-time attendance on MIB premises, in Trieste, from October 2026 to October 2027). In case of course abandonment or exclusion for any reason, no amount of the scholarship will be paid or reimbursed.

MIB Trieste School of Management was founded as a non-profit organization in Trieste in 1988 through the joint efforts of high profile companies and the world of academia. The School organizes masters and postgraduate programs with a strong international focus and does research in the main areas of International Management.

The Master in Insurance & Risk Management is accredited at the national level by ASFOR and at the European level by EFMD and its target are future professionals, aspiring to develop their careers in Insurance, Finance, Risk Management and Consultancy at a global level. The Master's program is entirely taught in English. It aims at developing the participants' managerial competencies and provides them with technical tools and working instruments immediately applicable on-the-job.

The candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Citizens of member countries of the European Union;
- Academic degree preferably in Economics or in a quantitative subject (e.g.: Economics, Finance, Business Administration, Actuarial and Statistical Sciences, Mathematics, Engineering);
- Good working knowledge of English and of another foreign language in addition to their mother tongue;
- Born in 1999 or later.

Assicurazioni Generali S.p.A. in collaboration with MIB Trieste School of Management will grant the Scholarship to the best candidate based on educational qualifications, professional skills and on the outcome of the selection process (written tests and motivational interview).

The beneficiary of the full tuition waiver will have to carry out a 6-month internship (from Mid-June 2027) at Assicurazioni Generali offices in Milan or in Trieste. A monthly allowance\* to assist with living costs, will be assured during the internship.

\* If the trainee's residence/domicile coincides with the place of work or allows commuting within a 50km range, the reimbursement corresponds to €800 +canteen. If the office does not allow commuting (distance between residence/domicile and office >50km) the reimbursement corresponds to €1000 + canteen.

To apply for the Scholarship, applicants must complete the on-line application form at www.mib.edu/mirm, (listing the "Diego Sastre García Scholarship" in the Scholarship field) and attach the following documents:

- A detailed CV
- A motivational letter
- Degree certificate and academic transcript
- Contact details (name, role, email address) of 2 reference persons (academics or professionals), for possible reference check
- Copy of passport or ID
- If available, a certificate demonstrating adequate knowledge of English such as TOEFL/IELTS/PTE, alternatively School's tests will be taken;
- If available, a deductive reasoning test score such as GMAT, alternatively School's tests will be taken.

The online application and required documents must be submitted by 28<sup>th</sup> June 2026. The selection process will be completed by 13<sup>th</sup> July 2026.
