1. Update on the meeting with the School

On Wednesday the 21st at 17:30, a delegation of the Board met virtually with the Dean Tracogna, Carolina Meucci, and Fabia Radetti. A follow-up call took place shortly afterward (Jan 27th) between Laura Prinzi, Maria Avelia De Lorenzis and Fabia Radetti. Below the summary of the topics discussed on the mentioned meetings:

- Fabia Radetti was introduced as the main contact person for operational relations between the Alumni Association and the MIB School Board.
- All operational communications should be addressed to her, with the School's communication team in copy.
- Prof Tracogna gave feedback about the last Reunion held in Milan and on Venice in 2024. Such discussion has been the starting point to argue about the next Reunion. After checking institutional school meetings and ceremonies' dates and considering the expiration of the Association board's term, it has been defined to hold the Reunion 2026 on Oct 17th by Palazzo Ferdinando in Trieste. The Association board needs to submit proposal on the main topics of the Reunion and format.
- The board representatives introduced the type of activities to be implemented in 2026 for the Association. In addition to the already-known MIB Talk events, the possibility of organizing webinars and participating as a school in sports events, including running races and a potential side event to support the MIB football cup. For all the activities benefits and challenges of their organization have been discussed.
- Some former students have been sending the board requests for information about possible school placement services. Prof Tracogna confirmed that there is no specific placement activities

from school, but recently the school has implemented an elective to help senior professionals reposition themselves.

2. Discussion on Reunion 2026 format and topics

Based on the above-mentioned feedback from the School meeting, the board agreed on suggesting the following Reunion format:

- Full-day event
- Start between **11:30 and 12:00**
- **12:00–13:00:** Keynote speech
- **13:00–14:30:** Networking Lunch
- **Afternoon:**
 - 1 panel discussion
 - 3 workshops
- **17:00–18:00:** General Assembly with the announcement of the new Board of Association

Such format is designed to allow people coming from outside the region to reach the meeting comfortably and to have proper time for networking.

About the topics, the Board reviewed the results of the alumni survey conducted in 2024 that collects the most interesting arguments for the alumni community. Some of the topics have been already considered in the previous 2 Reunions. Therefore, the topics that could be proposed for the Reunion 2026 are:

- Artificial Intelligence and managerial work: growth of human capabilities or erosion of the decision-making role?
- Leadership in an era of structural uncertainty: success, failure, and the redefinition of professional identity
- Space Economy: the new frontier transforming markets, technologies, and everyday life
- From Space to the Market: how the Space Economy is reshaping business models and global competitiveness

To select the final topic, the board proposes sending another survey to the alumni network

3. Discussion on the 2026 Association activities plan

The Board discussed the possibility of organizing the following activities in the remaining term.

- **MIB Talk Activities:** 2 events in Milan, 1 event in Trieste, 2 events in Pordenone.
- **Webinars:** 2 webinars, the first of which could be held on March 26th – proposed time 18:30 to allow broader participation
- **Sports and Community Engagement Activities:** Proposal to promote two sports competitions and a social bike ride:
- **Milan Marathon** – April 12th <https://www.milanomarathon.it/relay-marathon/>
- **Trieste Bavisela** – May 3rd <https://triestespringrun.com/>
- **Social Ride** is an activity promoted by the Association "OnBoard", set by former EMBA 23 alumni, that includes a bike route with two options suitable for families. The ideal period: late May / early June

4. Next steps

The finalized programming will be shared with Fabia Radetti in order to deliver it to the School board
